INSPECTION OF THE PROVISIONAL REGISTER OF VOTERS

The Electoral Commission of Zambia wishes to inform all stakeholders and the general public that the inspection of the Provisional Register of Voters will take place in all the 20 Registration Centres namely; Chinsali, Chipata, Choma, Chongwe, Kabompo, Kabwe, Kasama, Kitwe, Livingstone, Lundazi, Lusaka, Mansa, Mbala, Mkushi, Mongu, Nakonde, Nchelenge, Ndola, Sesheke and Solwezi.

Inspection of the Provisional Register of Voters will take place from **25th March, 2024 to 24th June, 2024 in all the 20 Voter Registration Centres.**

The inspection period will be during working hours from **Monday to Friday** alongside Continuous Registration of Voters.

All registered voters must take note of the following during the inspection period;


- Registered voters must inspect their personal details in the provisional Register of voters at any of the 20 Provincial Registration Centres to verify their details and correct any clerical errors.

- Any individual interested in other voters' details can inspect the Voters Register at any of the 20 Provincial Registration Centres.
- Anyone wishing to inspect the Provisional Register of Voters must carry with them the green National Registration Card and a Voters Card.
- Inspection can **ONLY** be done physically at the Registration Centres.

Other services that will be offered during the inspection period are as follows;

1. **Transfers** - from one polling station to another.
2. **Replacement of a voters card in cases of** - a lost, destroyed, damaged or defaced voters card, change of names or correction/amendment of clerical errors.
3. **Objections** - to an omission or appearance of a name in the Register of Voters.
4. **Appeals** - against refusal to include ones name in the Register.
5. **Claim** - for inclusion in the Register of Voters- A claim by a registered voter to be included in the Register of Voters in the event that they are not appearing.
6. **Removal of deceased voters** - Removal of the deceased voters from the Register of Voters.

Requirements: green NRC, Voters Card (if registered) and / or; Sworn Affidavit form.
